After 70 years of dedicated service, Ability Connection Colorado (ACCO) has hit a new milestone. Over 40,000 individuals and families received life changing support during the 2014-2015 fiscal year. ACCO staff and volunteers achieved this through family-initiated, family-driven grassroots programs. Each program has its own specialized focus, which provides critical resources for Colorado families and individuals. ACCO's umbrella of Statewide Family Support Programs include the following:

EMPOWER Colorado is fellow parents offering wisdom, encouragement and resources to families whose children are coping with mental health issues.

Faith in Action assists adults with disabilities in activities of daily living, including transportation, while recruiting Circles of Friends within faith-based communities to provide continual support.

Guardíanship Allíance of Colorado ensures the rights and dignity of adults with impaired decision-making capacity and protects their ability and freedom of choice.

Infantile Scoliosis Outreach Program is the resource regarding progressive infantile scoliosis and the gentle, noninvasive Mehta Growth Guidance Casting Method.

JP Prescription Drug Awareness Foundation raises awareness about the dangers of accidental prescription drug overdose, which causes a death every 15 minutes in the U.S. ONE PILL CAN KILL.

Parent to Parent of Colorado connects families whose children have disabilities and/or special healthcare needs to vital information from parents who have been there, including One to One Parent Matching, access to a confidential online information network, and Parent Wisdom files.
