Health & Safety – Summer Safety Tips:



With summer quickly approaching, we are all spending more time outside. Here are six (6) child safety tips:

- Small children can drown in as little of 2 inches of water, however older children are at risk as well. Closely supervise children around water and wear life jackets as appropriate.
- Drink enough water and watch for heat exhaustion. Signs may include: dizziness/fainting, fever, cool skin, goose bumps, muscle cramps, or irritability.
- Car Safety: the inside of a car can heat up quickly. Make sure cars are locked to keep playing children out. Check temperatures of door handles, seats, etc.
- 4. Skin protection: wear sun screen and reapply every hour. Sit in shaded areas and wear hats and sun protective clothing.
- Bike safety: wear a helmet whenever riding a bike, tricycle, scooter, roller blades, etc. to protect the head from hitting the ground should a fall occur.
